

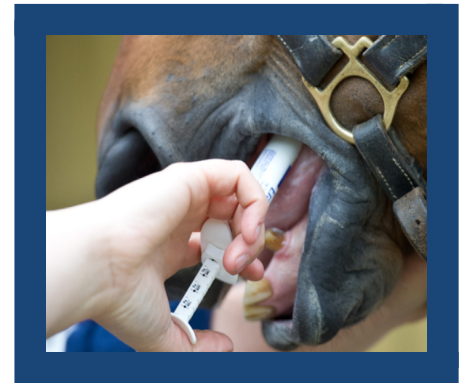


#### EMW Update

#### Equine Science Focus: Worm Watch

It is that time of year again to be thinking about testing your horse for worms! As part of a targeted approach to deworming your horse, it is important to work with veterinarians to see if your horse requires deworming. They will be able to help you select the right product and dosage for your horse. It is important to know the weight of your horse before deworming, either by weighbridge or tape. This ensures that your horse is being dosed correctly and helps tackle parasite resistance.

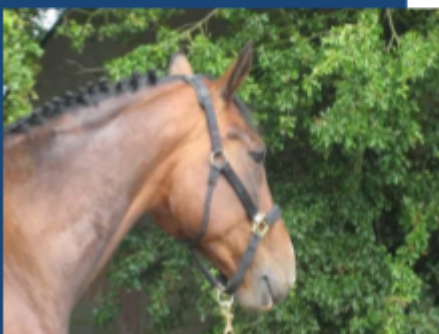
